

Our focus remains on meeting the needs of small-scale, commercial, and emerging commercial farmers in Zambia.

Regarding FISP 2024/2025, we supplied 31,600 MT under DIS and 74,000 MT under the e-voucher program. Notably, the 2024/25 season saw no significant complaints, thanks to UCF's prominent role in both programs. We're confident that in the 2025/2026 farming season, we'll improve further, ensuring timely fertilizer delivery to farmers.






